Date: Tuesday 31 January 2023 **Cost:** \$116

Time: Assemble at 12.15pm at Fred Caterson Reserve. We leave at 12.30 pm. Bus returns approximately 8.30 pm. Turn into Caterson Drive from Gilbert Road. Turn right at the next intersection and follow the road to the huge car park at the top of the hill.

Departing after lunch, our afternoon begins with a rambling drive to the Sydney Fish Markets on Blackwattle Bay. Our focus today is showcasing some of our beautiful waterways featuring bays and coves around Sydney Harbour. We will collect lots of fresh seafood for our twilight BBQ (including oysters, prawns, fish and smoked salmon) and there will be the opportunity to buy seafood to take home – eskies and ice will be provided for individual purchases.

We will visit the Baha'i Temple at Ingleside where we will enjoy afternoon tea and a guided tour of the temple, a video presentation and discussion time in the Information Centre and time to explore the gardens.

We will then enter Ku-ring-gai National Park via McCarrs Creek and travel out to Commodore Heights. This section of the park was included in 1951 and offers truly spectacular views over Broken Bay. While our sumptuous dinner is being prepared at the picnic area (a short distance inland), there will be time for a short walk to take in some of the most picturesque scenery imaginable over Pittwater and across to Palm Beach and Barrenjoey Headland and over the Hawkesbury River and across to the Central Coast, or just relax in the tranquillity!
