

# TOURS AND OUTINGS DAY TOURS

#### **AUGUST 19 - North Head Quarantine Station and Northern Beaches Ramble**

Date: Friday 19 August 2022

Cost: \$86

Time: Assemble at 8.45 am at Fred Caterson Reserve. We leave at 9.00 am. Bus returns

approximately 4.30 pm. Turn into Caterson Drive from Gilbert Road. Turn right at the next

intersection and follow the road to the huge car park at the top of the hill.

We commence our day travelling to Manly Beach where we will set up morning tea and enjoy the stunning panorama. From there we travel to the Quarantine Station, aptly named Q Station, located within a 30 hectare site at the North Head of Manly and an enduring part of Sydney's history that once served as the Quarantine Station for migrants arriving in Australia. Q Station buildings have been kept in pristine original condition with the old yellow paint colours, heavy window panes and high ceilings, all part of the building landscape.

On arrival at the Reception area we will transfer to a smaller mini bus to make our way down through the National Park to the wharf. Here we will be met by our guide as they share the history of the Quarantine Station and discover the process of the buildings in the Wharf Precinct, including the hospital.

After the tour we have lunch at The Terrace, still within the grounds of the Q Station, consisting of a selection of Chef made sandwiches, small selection of cakes and fruit platter as well as coffee and tea.

The focus of the afternoon will be our tour of the sparkling Northern Beaches taking in some truly sublime views and exploring every little nook and cranny. We will travel through Queenscliff, Freshwater, Curl Curl, Dee Why, Long Reef, Collaroy, Narrabeen before heading home.

Cost per person is \$86.00 p.p. which includes morning tea, guided tour, lunch consisting of sandwiches, cakes, fruits and tea and coffee and coach transport. Departs at 9.00 am and returns at approximately 4.30 pm.

## SEPTEMBER 13 - Bare Island, La Perouse, Botany Bay and Southern Beaches Tour

Date: Tuesday 13 September 2022

Cost: \$82

Time: Assemble at 8.15 am at Fred Caterson Reserve. We leave at 8.30am. Bus returns approximately

4.30 pm. Turn into Caterson Drive from Gilbert Road. Turn right at the next intersection and

follow the road to the huge car park at the top of the hill.

Our tour commences with morning tea at La Perouse before our guided tour of Bare Island. Located within the Botany Bay National Park, Bare Island Fort is situated at the mouth of Botany Bay. The fort was built in 1885 to protect the 'back door' of Sydney from attack by sea. Cross the wooden bridge (approximately 50 meters) and enter a world of military pride, fire engineering and great deception. Our guided tour will last approximately 1.5 hours.

Our two course lunch is at the Coogee Legion Club. We will tour the coastline from La Perouse on the northern entrance of Botany Bay, passing Little Bay, Malabar and Maroubra before reaching our destination at the Legion Club in Coogee. Here you will have a choice of main courses, dessert and tea or barista coffee while enjoying the water views from our reserved seating.

Following lunch we will continue with our tour of the Southern Beaches to Watsons Bay. We will travel through Coogee, Bronte, Tamarama and Bondi beaches and finish up through Vaucluse, Rose Bay, Double Bay and Woollahra.

Cost per person is \$82.00 and includes morning tea, two course lunch with tea or barista coffee, guided tour and coach touring. Departs at 8.30 am and returns at approx. 4.30pm.
